Peace of mind

Making a will is about ensuring your wishes are carried out after you die. When you take your home, belongings and savings into account, you may be surprised at the value of your estate. Having an up-to-date, professionally-written will gives you the chance to put your affairs in order and avoids any confusion about your wishes after you die.

There are different ways to leave a legacy. These are the most common:

- **Specific legacy** – leaving a particular item in your will such as an item of jewellery, a house or shares
- **Pecuniary legacy** – specifying a fixed amount of money to be left as a gift
- **Residuary legacy** – choosing to leave what is left of your estate once all specific and pecuniary legacies have been made.

If you already have one it is a good idea to review your will regularly. You can change it as often as you like. If you would like to add to a gift to The West of England MS Therapy Centre (Registered Charity No. 801155), please ask your solicitor about an alteration called a **codicil**.



Tax efficiency

Legacies to registered charities in the UK are tax exempt. If you leave money to The West of England MS Therapy Centre or another charity in your will, it will be paid out before inheritance tax is deducted, reducing the total amount of tax paid on the estate.



When I first visited The West of England MS Therapy Centre 25 years ago, I had to be fed, washed and I could not see or speak. Now I walk with a stick and I have a good quality of life.

Life was scary before I knew of the Centre; 27 years ago I remember walking to work and with each step it felt like the ground was coming up at me. Months later I experienced problems with my legs, bladder and had a bad case of double vision. I went to the opticians where I was advised to go to hospital straight away. I had a lumbar puncture and was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis (MS). I also discovered I was pregnant and I was given the choice to have a termination. Luckily I didn't, my son is now 25 years of age, studying to be a mechanical engineer, and my youngest son is working in the family business.

I have Oxygen Treatment and Physiotherapy at the Centre, it is a lifeline and it's just brilliant. You can just walk into the Centre and talk to people, get tips, advice – the best therapy you can get!
